Camp Sessions

Camp runs for seven weeks, Monday-Friday from 9-3. Below is a list of our sessions and weekly themes planned for each week.

Week 1 (June 21-25): Rock Hounds

We study and collect different kinds of rocks, learn about rock formation and change, and celebrate geology.

Week 2 (June 28- July 2): Ponds

We visit ponds and learn about the defining characteristics of this habitat and the creatures which call ponds home.

Week 3 (July 6- 9 *No Camp Monday, July 5): Fields and Streams

We consider streams and meadows, water movement, wildflowers, and birds.

Week 4 (July 12-16): Marshes

We explore the special world of estuaries and learn about why they are an important part of our world.

Week 5 (July 19-23): Forests

We examine forest ecology, learning about different kinds of trees and plants and the animals that live among them.

Week 6 (July 26-30): Animal Friends

This week we take a close look at animals that are a part of the human world – farm, working, and domesticated animals.

Week 7 (August 2-6): Beaches

We celebrate and enjoy the beach and it's treasures through projects and adventures.
