



Child Care Programs

Facilitated Play

Our facilitated Play Room is Cricket Hunt School's child care component. This program is a full time licensed flexible child care program, open year-round (49 weeks). This program provides a nurturing, relaxed, home-like environment. We welcome children to this program ages 12-36 months, and will gladly give preference to siblings who may need care outside of their regular preschool day. We maintain low staff ratios in an engaging atmosphere. A developmental curriculum is used to help your child reach appropriate developmental milestones. Your child will interact with peers in a language rich environment. Outside play, music and large motor activities are a regular part of your young child's day. Facilitated Play is closed on major holidays and for 3 full weeks for vacation and cleaning. Please see schedule.

Before School Care

Cricket Hunt School is pleased to offer before school care. Drop-off time for before school care is at 7:30 AM. Your children are supervised by Facilitated Play staff in the Facilitated Play Room until 8:00 AM. At 8:00 AM, upper grade or preschool staff will transition children to their respective classrooms. *An additional fee of \$4.00 per day is required for before school care.*

After School Care

Our After School Care programs are multi-aged groupings of (our) preschool and elementary school students. The purpose of our After Care program is to allow children the open-ended freedom to play with friends in a supervised outdoor environment. Families can have peace of mind knowing that their children will meander through their afternoons, engaging bodies and minds in imaginative, gross motor play. Cricket Hunt After School Care program provides a daily nutritious snack and beverage. After School Care contracts are written for only the days and times required by a family. After school hours are 3:00 PM – 5:30 PM and care is provided on the days that Cricket Hunt School is in session. The fee for after school care is \$7.00 per hour. There is no after care available on the first and last days of the school year.

Inclement Weather

The care and safety of our students, staff and families has always and will continue to be of the highest priority. Therefore, if inclement weather is considered dangerous enough to close schools, our childcare program will be closed as well. We do not wish to unnecessarily inconvenience anyone, however, safety will always be considered first when making a decision to close the school and child care facility.
